Greetings Parents & Guardians,

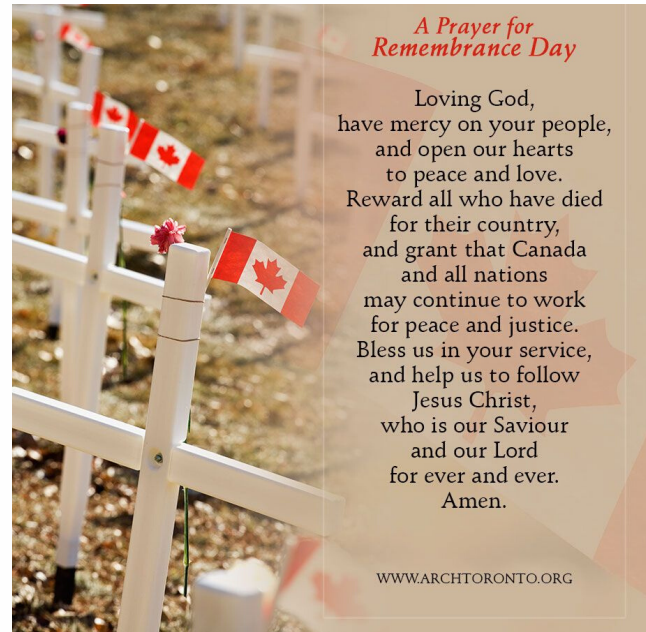
