Their task was to compose a song to support mindfulness practice using the Garageband App.

FDK Bee Bots Workshop

On April 28th, our Kindergarten students had a wonderful day participating in an engaging and interactive STEM Minds workshop focused on coding. During this exciting session, the children were introduced to Bee-Bots—colorful, easy-to-use robots designed especially for young learners.

Through hands-on exploration, students learned foundational coding skills while having fun navigating Bee-Bots across various themed mats. They practiced counting, sequencing, directionality, problem-solving, and estimation, all while developing an early understanding of coding concepts.
